

STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)	£1283.00
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£593.00
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	£150.00
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's branch premises.	£150.00
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from elm wood effect.	£160.00
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	£50.00
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£180.00

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£1098.00
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)²	£1518.00

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.

Why are the fees different to what else you have on your website?

The Competitions and Markets Authority have instructed all funeral directors to create a standardised price list to make comparing funeral directors easier for the public.

This fee does not include any third party costs (crematorium/cemetery, church, minister etc), and should include our professional fees, the collection and care of the deceased, a coffin (we've used our Gwent Coffin), a viewing, a date and time that you agree with, suitable transport (we've used our Estate Hearse) and enough people to pall bear (we've quoted for four).

This does not mean that you need to have everything stated above, remember, we will tailor each funeral to your individual needs; meaning you don't pay for what you don't use.

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (these are just our fees, you will also need to add any burial and grave purchase fees) £1098.00

Cremation (we've quoted for Thornhill Crematorium but there are various crematoriums for you to choose from) £1518.00

Because we operate throughout South Wales (there are four local authorities within 15 minute drive from us), we wanted to make sure that we quote all the fees that may be applicable.
